NOTICE

Course Registration:

- Students are required to register courses through KYOMU JOHO SYSTEM inside the campus when each term starts.
- During Course Registration Period, students are allowed to log in to the KYOMU JOHO SYSTEM anytime. (Available from 9:00 AM of the first day until 5:00 PM of the final day)
- Make sure that your registration is properly completed.
 - If you find any errors, please ask Educational Affairs Division.
- Pre-registration periods are for those lottery courses which have students number limitation. Maximum number of available students are shown right side of Class Codes on the Class Schedule. Students who wish to take them must register during the pre-registration period.

Cancellation of Courses

- If students want to cancel their course(s), they are required to apply for the cancellation via the through KYOMU JOHO SYSTEM during the Cancellation Periods of each term.
- Courses not cancelled during Cancellation Periods, but the student does not attend, does not take final exam, or does not submit the reports are basically considered as Abondoned (score of H is given).
- Cancellation is applicable to elective courses and elective required courses. Note that intensive courses are not subject to course cancellation.
- It is not allowed to add courses during Cancellation Periods. Cancellation outside of this period is also not allowed.

Intensive Courses:

- Intensive courses should be also registered during Registration Periods.
- However, when the special registration period is announced for specific courses, students can register or cancel at the Educational Affairs Division.
- Schedule of intensive courses will be posted on the KYOMU JOHO SYSTEM, when the details are fixed.
- Those intensive courses whose schedules are not finalized are shown on both Spring and Fall terms on the Class Schedule. Some intensive courses may not be held in the shown term.
 - Please check the KYOMU JOHO SYSTEM frequently for the latest information.

For B4 students:

- As *Jitsumu-Kunren* (Internship) is a compulsory subject, you are required to register it for the Fall-2.
 - *You cannot register any other courses of Fall term or Fall-2. (Only Fall-1 courses are available.)

Thesis Research, Supervised Research, Supervised Experiments and Seminars:

■ All the full-year courses are required to register in Spring term. (Those students entering Fall term should do so in Fall term.) Please ask your supervisor for the details of these courses.

Kentei Eigo (Recognition of Credits based on Foreign Language Proficiency Tests) for undergraduate students:

You can apply for the recognition of credits from the results of English Tests (TOEFL, TOEIC etc.) at Educational Affairs Division. The application must be submitted by the last day of each term's examination (except optional extra days).
