

【Students and faculty members】 How to respond to symptoms and the flow of contact to the university

1. Awareness of physical problems such as difficulty breathing, strong fatigue, and fever

- ✓ Consult a medical institution directly by telephone(*1)(*2)
- ✓ Consult [the TUT Health Care Center](#)
- ✓ Do not come to the university two days after the symptoms disappear

(*1) If your family doctor is not available during the year-end and New Year holidays, please consult with your local government's holiday and night service office.

(In Toyohashi City, the telephone number for the emergency night-time clinic is 0532-48-1110.)

(*2) If you are not sure where to go, call the Medical Consultation Center or the TUT Health Care Center for advise.

2. When the public health center identifies you as a close contact person with an infected person

- ✓ Stay at home according to instructions from the public health center
- ✓ Contact [the TUT Health Care Center](#)
- ✓ Do not come to the university

3. ○When a family member who lives with you is identified as a close contact person with an infected person
○When the person is not identified as a close contact person but is suspected to have made a close contact
